

## Archers Progress Scheme

1. To get novice archers used to scoring systems and having their scores witnessed, as in competitions.
2. To allow archers to build up confidence at shorter distances before progressing to longer distances. Preventing the inevitable confidence eroding effects of moving too quickly to longer distances.
3. To give archers a challenge that develops at longer distances to be representative of good quality shooting.

### The Round

**The round:** 3 dozen arrows

**Scoring:** Imperial 5 zone scoring

**Distance:** Various – 20, 30, 40, 50 and 60 yards

**Target Score:** The same score, based on the bow type being used, is used at all distances (see table below). Whilst the score is more easily obtained at short distances it becomes a challenge at longer ones.

**Repeats:** The target score needs to be achieved three times to earn the reward and to move to the next distance.

**Reward:** Archery GB Progress Award Badges. 20yds = white, 30yds = black, 40yds = blue, 50yds = red, 60yds = gold
